**Yi-Zarn Wang, M.D., D.D.S., F.A.C.S.** is a Professor of Surgery at Louisiana State University Health Sciences College School of Medicine. He is a member of the multidisciplinary team at the Ochsner Neuroendocrine Tumor Program in Kenner, Louisiana. His clinical interests include hepatobiliary, pancreatic surgery, radiofrequency and Nanoknife ablation of solid tumors. Dr. Wang received his dental training in Taiwan. He entered the graduate program in oral/general pathology at OHSU in Portland, Oregon where he obtained his medical degree. He went to the Barnes Hospital/ Washington University Surgical Residency Program in St. Louis, Missouri where he received world-class surgical oncology discipline under numerous renowned surgeons. He joined the faculty at LSUHSC in New Orleans in 1994. Before Hurricane Katrina, he served as Chief of General Surgery and Director of Surgical Education and ran the surgical cancer care for indigent patients in Louisiana.



**Marian Porubsky, MD** is an Assistant Professor of Surgery, Section of Abdominal Transplant at Banner University Medical Center. He received his M.D. from Komensky University in Slovakia. He completed general surgery residency at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and fellowship in abdominal transplant surgery at the Indiana University Indianapolis, Indiana. He joined the Department of Surgery at Banner University Medical Center after the completion of abdominal transplant fellowship in 2012.
